

BOBBY QUILLEN MEMORIAL PACE FOR 2010

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND OLDER PACERS IN 2010

OWNED AND SPONSORED BY: Harrington Raceway, Inc. ("Sponsor").
 SERVICED BY: The Hambletonian Society, Inc. ("Society").
 FOR: Three-year-olds and older pacers in 2010 (Subject to U.S.T.A. Foaling Date Rules).

TO BE RACED AS: One race for three-year-olds and older pacers plus any elimination races if necessary, which is named the Bobby Quillen Memorial Pace ("Pace").

TO BE RACED AT: Harrington Raceway ("Track"), Harrington, Delaware. Dates will be published in the *U.S.T.A. Stakes Guide*. If for any reason it becomes impractical or undesirable, in the opinion of the Sponsor to hold either one or more of the Pace at the Track designated, the Sponsor reserves the right to change the date and/or the location of either any or all races of the Pace.

CANCELLATION: The Sponsor further reserves the right to cancel the Pace, if it becomes impractical or undesirable in the opinion of the Sponsor to conduct said race(s). If the Pace is not raced, the Sponsor and the Society's responsibility and liability will be limited to refunding without interest nomination, sustaining and Entrance Fees collected toward the canceled event that have not been disbursed at the time of cancellation. These monies will be prorated among the Owners of the horses eligible as of the time of cancellation.

PURSE: Estimated 2010 Final purse:
 Bobby Quillen Memorial Pace..... \$300,000

ADDED MONEY: Harrington Raceway will add \$250,000 to the race.

PAYMENTS: (U.S. Funds only)
 April 15, 2010 --Nomination payment (nomination)\$1,000
 Entrance Fee\$2,500

Nominated horses (including supplemented horses) must be properly identified to the satisfaction of the Society at the time of nomination, including but not limited to certifying that the nominated or supplemented horse is registered as a twin or as the only foal of the mare in the year of foaling, or, if produced through embryo/ovum transfer, is the donor mare's first born foal that year. The Owner(s) ("Owner", which includes all beneficial owners at the time) of the nominated or supplemented horse agree to indemnify and hold the Society, the Track and the Sponsor harmless from any and all claims, suits or damages, including attorney's fees, arising out of or related in any way to such certification.

SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS: Horses otherwise not nominated in April may be made eligible to the Pace by a supplemental nomination of \$5000 due on or before July 15, 2010.

July 15, 2010—Supplemental nomination.....\$5,000

DECLARATION: Entrance Fee shall be due with declaration to start at the Track where the Pace is being held at the time and date posted on the Track's Condition Sheet and payable not later than one hour prior to post time of the first race to be contested. All Entrance Fees shall be made payable to The Hambletonian Society Inc. Except as provided in U.S.T.A. Rule 12, Section 2, there shall be no refunds for scratched horses.

At the time of declaration a starter must meet the qualifying standards of the Track. A horse will have been considered to have met Harrington Raceway's qualifying standard if it has a clean charted line (no breaks) and meets the current time requirement of Harrington Raceway within 30 days of race.

SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATIONS: Supplementary entries will be accepted at time of declarations by a payment of \$25,000. No further payment is required.

Supplement Declarations\$25,000

Supplemental declarations are due & payable at the Track where the race is being held at the time and date posted on the Condition Sheet. All starting and supplemental Entrance Fees shall be made payable to The Hambletonian Society.

NOTICE: U.S.T.A. Rule 11, Section 3 provides: "Failure to make any payment required by the conditions constitutes an automatic withdrawal from the event." The Hambletonian Society, Inc. will construe payment to require that cash or check duly honored upon presentation be received at the time specified in U.S.T.A. Rule 12, Section 4.

IMAGE WAIVER: As a condition of participation in the Bobby Quillen Memorial Pace 2010, the Owner(s) of the nominated horse(s) hereby grants to the Sponsor, its representatives, successors, and assigns the absolute right to copyright and publish, use or reuse still and motion photographic images of its horses, drivers, trainers, employees, officers and agents, in whole or in part, in composite or in distorted character, with or without use of names, in color or otherwise, for the purpose of promotion, advertising, trade or other lawful purpose in any and all media. Owner(s) waives any right to inspect and/or approve the finished product or the copy that may be used in connection therewith or the use to which it might be applied. Owner(s) further agrees to inform his drivers, trainers, employees, officers and agents of the authority granted to the Society, the Track and the Sponsors herein, to hold Society, the Track and the Sponsor harmless from any and all liability and damages, and to indemnify the Society, the Track and the Sponsors from same should any such Owner(s), driver(s), trainer(s), employee(s), officer(s) and agent(s) challenge Society, the Track and the Sponsor's rights as set forth above.

RACING CONDITIONS: All events one dash at one mile. Declarations for the eliminations will close at the time and date posted on the Track's Condition Sheet.

Eight horses will constitute a full field for the final.
 If nine horses enter, one elimination race for the nine horses will be raced for a purse of \$30,000. The horse finishing last will be the also eligible (AE1) for the final. (In case of a dead heat for last in the elimination, those horses will draw by lot to determine which horse(s) race(s) and which is AE1)

10 or more entries will result in elimination divisions.
 Eliminations, if necessary, will race for a minimum purse of \$25,000 each race, if there are more than two (2) elimination races. If there are two (2) elimination races, the minimum purse will be \$30,000. Such eliminations for the Pace will be held in accordance with U.S.T.A Rule 13 and the Delaware Harness Racing Commission, except as provided below:

If there are two (2) elimination races the first four (4) finishers in each will return for the final.

If there are three (3) elimination races the first two (2) finishers in each will return for the final and the third place finishers will draw by lot for the remaining two (2) spots to comprise a field of eight (8) starters for the final.

If there are four (4) elimination races the first two (2) finishers in each will return for the final.

If there are five (5) or more elimination races the five or more winners will return for the final, with the horses finishing second drawing by lot to comprise a field of eight (8) starters for the final. Post positions for the final will drawn by lot.

In addition, two horses will be selected from those in the eliminations that do not qualify for the final to be designated "Also Eligible" ("AE") for each final. The preference to determine which is the first "Also Eligible" ("AE1") shall be determined by taking the horse that placed highest in the official order of finish of all elimination races, but did not qualify for the final; in the event horses are equal in the finish position, final preference will be determined by lot. The other horse will be the second "Also Eligible" ("AE2").

All horses making the final will automatically be entered by the Race Secretary.

If because of an accident in the elimination race, an insufficient number of horses finish the race and qualify for the final, the remaining finalist and "Also Eligibles" will be selected by lot from the remaining non-offending horses in that elimination where the accident occurred.

All starters are subject to the detention policy of the Track.

MONEY DIVISION: Purses for all races will be divided 50-25-12-8-5% and paid by the Hambletonian Society

DRIVERS AND TRAINERS FEES: The drivers and trainers fees will be disbursed by the Society in accordance with the policy of the Track at the time of the race.

PROTESTS, INVESTIGATIONS AND/OR DISPUTES: In the event of any protest, investigation or dispute with respect to the results of the Bobby Quillen Memorial Pace 2010 or any races related thereto, the Society may, if it is in possession of the purse, at its option deliver the purse, or the disputed portion thereof, to the Track which shall hold such purse in a segregated interest-bearing bank account, to be disbursed by the Track following the final binding and non-appealable determination of any such protest, investigation or dispute. Further, the Owner shall hold the Society, the Track and the Sponsors, their officers, directors, members, employees and agents harmless from, against and in respect of any and all claims, actions, losses, damages, liabilities, judgment, costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees and disbursements) resulting from any such protest, investigation or dispute.

DISPUTES: In the case of any dispute as to the interpretation of these conditions, the decision of the Sponsor shall be final. All fees and payments in any race are accepted on the condition that all claims, objections and appeals arising out of these races or with respect to any interpretation of any rules or conditions of the races, or otherwise shall be decided by Sponsor, which decision shall be final and not subject to appeal. Any appeal rights which the Owner(s) shall otherwise have are waived.

RULES: Unless otherwise specified hereinabove and except as may be affected by the Delaware Harness Racing Commission rules, U.S.T.A. rules not in conflict with these conditions to govern, as well as the Track rules & regulations. The rules shall be those in effect at the time of the race.
