### **ABOUT HARRAH'S HOOSIER PARK**

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino, a part of Caesars Entertainment, Inc., is one of the Indianapolis-area's premier entertainment destinations with nearly three million visitors each year.

The property features a spacious, single-level casino floor featuring the hottest slots and live table games, a sports book, world-renowned harness racing, premier dining and first-class entertainment.

Harrah's Hoosier Park's live harness racing runs through December 9, and is highlighted by the \$300,000 Dan Patch Stakes, \$200,000-est. Caesars Trotting Classic, Indiana Sires Stakes and the 2023 \$7 Million Breeders Crown. State-of-the-art simulcasting technology and spaces are available year-round.

Harrah's Hoosier Park also features two Winner's Circle Race Sports Pub locations in the heart of downtown Indianapolis and just minutes from downtown Fort Wayne in New Haven.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

#### **BACKSTRETCH INFORMATION**

The backstretch at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino offers a full range of business and hospitality amenities that include a track kitchen, tack shop, horsemen's lounge, dormitories, restrooms, locker rooms, and shower facilities.

Dormitory room contracts are issued by the Dormitory Supervisor, Teena Walden, at (765) 609-4834.

The backstretch kitchen, The Horseshoe Café, is available for breakfast, specials, and short orders from early morning to the last race of the night during live racing. The facility closes after training hours on Monday and is closed all day on Sunday. To reach The Backstretch Kitchen call (765) 609-4844.

Midwest Harness Supply (MHS) is located just outside the racing office on the backside and provides high quality horse supplies. MHS is open both during the racing and off season.

#### SHIP-IN INFORMATION

When shipping into Harrah's Hoosier Park, you must provide the following mandatory documents at the security gate:

- A current coggins dated within the past 12 months
- Proof of equine herpes vaccination dated within the past six months
- A health certification dated within 30 days if shipping in from out-of state

Health papers will not be written at the gate for incoming horses. Harrah's Hoosier Park will designate two barns on the backside exclusively for horses shipping in for the Breeders Crown eliminations and finals. Ship-ins staying multiple nights must make arrangements by contacting the race office at (765) 609-4880, (756) 609-4881, or (765) 609-4869.





#### LICENSE INFORMATION

All backside personnel must be licensed by the Indiana Horse Racing Commission (IHRC) and only licensed personnel and authorized persons will be allowed in the stable or paddock area. A license application can be obtained using the following options: Online, via email/fax, or you can visit the licensing office. IHRC licensing staff are available via phone or e-mail to assist racing participants seeking information or application forms. Participants are strongly encouraged to apply for a license prior to visiting the track licensing office by using one of the three processes described.

You can access the commission's online license process by visiting https:// www.in.gov/hrc/licensing/ (Tip - do not use Internet Explorer). When choosing the online licensing option, if you already have an account you need only to login, however, if you need to set up an account please click on "need to register" at the bottom of the box. Clicking this box will guide you through the process of setting up a user profile account. Please note this account is an individual user account, meaning multiple people cannot utilize the same account. When setting up your account it will ask for your IHRC license number. If you were licensed in Indiana previously, you are renewing a license and you already have an IHRC number. This is indicated on an IHRC issued photo ID badge or indicated on a receipt given by the IHRC. If you need help locating this number, please call one of our licensing offices - IHRC staff are happy to assist you. When you register for an account you will verify your email, and then you will begin the licensing application process. Upon completion of your application, you will be given an option to pay with your credit card (Visa/MasterCard/ Discover). Once your payment is made and your application has been submitted, an IHRC review will beain. Please note this process could take up to 3 business days to complete depending on submission date; possibly longer if additional information is required.

If the online process is not for you, we have the licensing forms on our website at https://www.in.gov/hrc/licensing/. Once your application is completed you can scan and email your application to INHorseracing@hrc.in.gov or you can fax it to (765) 683-2568. Upon our receipt of your application, an IHRC staff member will contact you regarding payment options over the phone or you may mail in your payment via U.S. mail or overnight.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

#### LICENSE INFORMATION CONTINUED

When visiting the licensing office at Hoosier Park, paper applications will be available outside the office. Due to space constraints, the IHRC asks that you have your paper application completed prior to your arrival. When visiting the office, please be mindful of the space constraints and long lines which can result in significant wait times.

#### **RETENTION AND POST TIMES**

Prior to the lucrative Breeders Crown finals, eliminations for these prestigious contests will occur on Thursday, October 19, Friday, October 20 & Saturday, October 21 with a post time of approximately 6:15 pm EDT each evening.

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino, in conjunction with the Hambletonian Society, has determined all horses competing in these races must be present on the grounds for a 12-hour retention period for the eliminations and a 24-hour retention period for the finals. For both the eliminations and finals, Harrah's Hoosier Park will provide two retention check-in times depending upon which race the respective horse is competing. Racing Office staff will inform horsemen of which time applies

Therefore, Harrah's Hoosier Park final arrival times are as follows:

#### **Eliminations**

Thursday, Oct. 19 - arrive Thursday, Oct. 19 - 8 or 10 am Friday, Oct. 20 - arrive Friday, Oct. 20 - 8 or 10 am Saturday, Oct. 21 - arrive Saturday, Oct. 21 - 8 or 10 am

#### **Finals**

Friday, Oct. 27 - arrive Thursday, Oct. 26 - 7 or 8pm Saturday, Oct. 28 - arrive Friday, Oct. 27 - 7 or 8pm

#### **DETENTION AND POST TIMES CONTINUED**

Harrah's Hoosier Park will have designated barns available for the Breeders Crown horses for both ship-in and detention purposes. Should horsemen have any inquiries in regards to detention barns, arrival times or post times, please contact Director of Racing, Scott Peine, at (765) 609-4870.

Please note first post for the Breeders Crown Eliminations is 6:15 pm and the first post for the Breeders Crown Finals on Friday, October 27 and Saturday, Oct. 28 is 6 pm.

- Horsemen should check the weekly condition sheet as Harrah's Hoosier Park will host races for those horses that did not make the Breeders Crown finals.
- Salix (Furosemide) reporting time is 4 hours and 50 minutes prior to the scheduled post time.

Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino will host the 2023 Breeders Crown on Friday, October 27 and Saturday, October 28. The 2023 event will be presented by the Indiana Standardbred Breed Development and the Indiana Standardbred Association.

In 2023, the freshmen Breeders Crown finals will take place on Friday, Oct. 27 and the eight three-year-old and up events will take place on Saturday, October 28. The freshmen events will compete for a purse of \$700,000, a purse level not reached for those divisions since 2008.

The 2023 Breeders Crown event, presented by Indiana Standardbred Breed Development in partnership with the Indiana Standardbred Association, will offer a variety of viewing experiences:
